9th Grade Getting Started

2 meetings: Fall & Spring

Meeting topics will include: Review academic schedule, and assist in mapping out academic courses and explain which courses are most crucial to college admissions. Point out potential red flags in your academic schedule. Discuss learning styles; help you develop effective study skills. Brainstorm involvement outside the classroom, initiate summer enrichment ideas, and plan personal goals.

10th Grade Time to Plan

Begin to create your college resume, including extracurricular activities, internships, employment, community service, hobbies and honors/awards.
